The City Council of the City of Boca Raton will be interviewing applicants to fill vacancies on the following Boards:

### **BUILDERS' BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT AND APPEALS**

Must be a City resident and a state-registered architect.

Hears and rules on appeals of decisions of the City's fire and building officials.

### **CITIZENS' PEDESTRIAN AND BIKEWAY ADVISORY BOARD**

Must be a qualified elector of the City.

Assists in implementing a pedestrian and bikeway system consistent with the requirements of the City's Comprehensive Plan.

### **CODE ENFORCEMENT BOARD**

Must be a City resident and an engineer or architect.

Conducts hearings related to enforcement of various occupational licenses and fire, building, zoning, sign and technical codes of the City in order to protect and improve the health, safety and welfare of the citizenry.

### **ELDER AFFAIRS ADVISORY BOARD**

Must be a qualified elector of the City.

Develops and offers recommendations to the City Council for policies, programs and legislation that supports elders and their needs.

### **GENERAL EMPLOYEES' PENSION BOARD**

Must be a City resident.

Applicants should have significant experience and expertise in regard to pension systems.

### **HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD**

Must be a City resident.

Promotes the educational, cultural, economic and general welfare of the City through the preservation and protection of sites and districts of historic interest and to preserve and protect the significant architectural phases of the community as it developed and grew in its historic past from the year 1925.

### **LIBRARY ADVISORY BOARD**

Must be a City resident.

Makes recommendations to City Council regarding management and operation of municipal libraries.

### **MARINE ADVISORY BOARD**

Must be a qualified elector of the City.

Must be affiliated with the Boca Raton Coast Guard Auxiliary. Makes recommendations to City Council regarding issues related to waterways within the City of Boca Raton.

### **PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD**

Must be a qualified elector of the City.

Should be well versed in environmental, planning and zoning matters, and sympathetic to municipal development consonant with the health, safety and welfare of its residents.

### **POLICE AND FIREFIGHTERS' PENSION BOARD**

Must be a City resident.

Applicants should have significant experience and expertise in regard to pension systems.

### **ZONING BOARD OF ADJUSTMENT**

Must be a qualified elector of the City.

Should be well versed in matters relating to the building code and zoning code of the City, familiar with the powers and duties of the Zoning Board of Adjustment and be in sympathy with the proposition that municipal development should be accomplished in furtherance of the protection of the public health, safety and welfare of the community and the comprehensive plan of the City.
